

ACT

This is a college entrance examination required by many colleges. The ACT Assessment measures college preparatory skills in English, mathematics, reading, and science. Registration packets, practice tests, and a study guide book are available in the counselor's office. If interested, see your counselor for more information. This exam can be taken as many times as a student wishes. Students may register online (www.act.org) or may mail in a registration packet. The cost is \$31 for act no writing and \$46 for the act plus writing. If finances are a problem, please see Mrs. Ming to see if you qualify for a fee waiver. The ACT test is not given at La Monte High School but can be taken at a number of locations, including Sedalia and Warrensburg. La Monte's school code for the ACT is 261-845.
